## **TRAVEL INFORMATION ON ARRIVAL IN GLASGOW**

### **On arrival at Glasgow Airport**

*SEC or SEC Campus Hotels (Crowne Plaza, Hilton Garden Inn, Campanile, The Village, Premier Inn Pacific Quay)*

The easiest way to travel to the SEC is by taxi. These are easily located just outside the terminal building or can be booked in advance on 0044 141 429 7070 from outside the UK, 0141 429 7070 from the UK. Quote GCB1 for pre-booked taxis to get a £2 discount. Travel time to the SEC is 15 minutes and costs approximately £12.

#### *City Centre Hotels*

Travel to the city centre takes 15-20 minutes depending on the location of your hotel. Taxis are available as above and cost around £16 before the discount. The Glasgow Airport Express Shuttle bus (#500 First Bus) departs for the city centre every 10 minutes and makes several stops in the city centre (click [here](#) for map). Journey time to the city centre is 20-25 minutes and it costs £7.50 one way or £10 return.

### **On arrival at Glasgow Central Train Station**

*SEC or SEC Campus Hotels (Crowne Plaza, Hilton Garden Inn, Campanile, The Village, Premier Inn Pacific Quay)*

Trains depart for the SEC (Exhibition Centre) from Platform 17 (low level) approximately every 10 minutes and takes just 3-4 minutes.

### **On arrival at Glasgow Prestwick Airport**

Trains and Buses (Stagecoach) depart every 20-30 minutes for Glasgow city centre. Journey time is 50 minutes.

### **On arrival at Edinburgh International Airport**

Edinburgh Airport is only 45 minutes from Glasgow. The best way to get to Glasgow from Edinburgh Airport would be to take the [Citylink Air](#) service which operates every 30 minutes at peak times, seven days a week, between Edinburgh Airport and Glasgow City Centre. It costs £11.60 one way or £19 return and you can buy a ticket from the driver on board.
